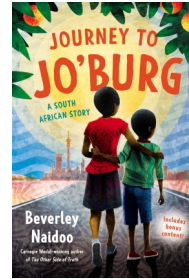

English:

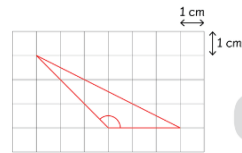
