English

Pupils have written vibrant poems about fireworks, skilfully using a variety of poetic devices such as simile, onomatopoeia, personification, and rhyme, to paint a vivid and captivating picture for the reader.

Mathematics

Pupils used the 'counting on' strategy

with concrete materials and number lines to add and subtract 6-digits numbers moving on to the column methods where renaming is required.

Science Topic: *Mysterious Materials*

In Science, pupils explored the States of Matter by categorising materials into solids, liquids, and gases. They successfully described the movement of particles

within each state, deepening their understanding of how matter behaves.

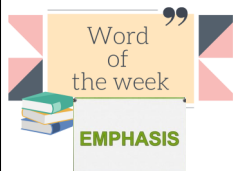
