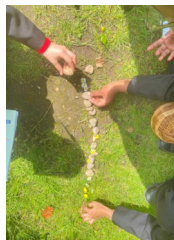
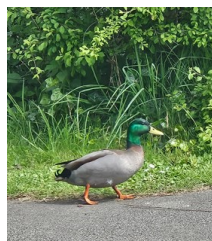

English:

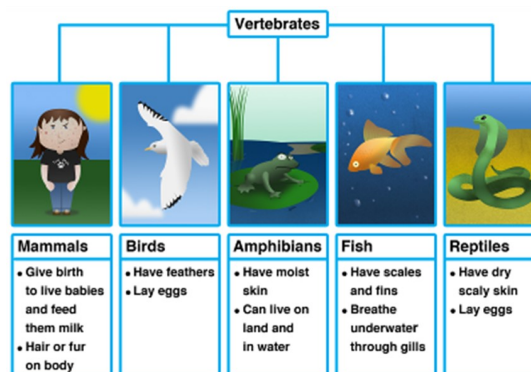
