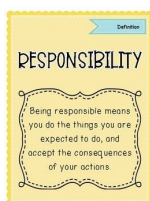

English:

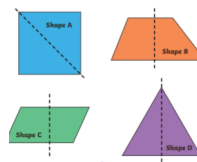
We completed all of our English assessments and our environmentally
