The girls were introduced to numbers to 1000 and the place value of hundreds, tens and ones. They used dienes to represent a range of three digit numbers. They also understood that a digit is 0,1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8. 9 and when combined together, they make a number.

They also partitioned three digit numbers using the number bond method and part, part whole. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

Next week, we are exploring place value in more detail, number patterns and counting in fifties.
