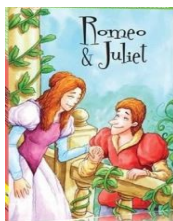


## Year 6 Newsletter 2

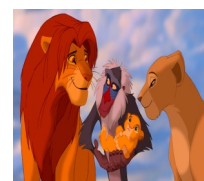
