This week, pupils were introduced to the new class text: The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe. They discussed the life of the author— CS Lewis. In Writing, they described narrator's feelings, providing context for a character description, which, they have started in the form of a letter. In Reading Comprehension, the "Prediction" skill was revisited.

In Maths, pupils continued multiplication. They multiplied 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers, using different strategies.

To commence our History topic, pupils discussed the causes of WW1 and WW2 and explored a timeline of events which led to the wars.

In PSHE, pupils participated in an assembly to commence the unit on *Celebrating Difference*. They discussed how people are completely unique and how special being unique is.

On Wednesday, pupils enjoyed a trip to the Tower of London, where they engaged in two taught sessions: *Crime and Punishment* and *Queens behind Henry*. They explored the White Tower, looking at armour throughout the centuries and also had the opportunity to view the Crown Jewels.
